RICO COMMUNITY CEMETERY

The Rico Community Cemetery is located on the property of Providence Baptist Church at 6402 Campbellton Redwine Rd, near the corner of Campbellton Redwine and Rico Roads.

History

When this area was settled in the early 1800's, Piney Woods Primitive Baptist Church was built on Kite Road as a one-room log cabin. Early settlers buried in the Piney Woods Cemetery near the church included the Ballards, Smiths, Yates, Lovelaces, Barfields, Burans, Garretts and others. On one side of the burial ground are the graves of the Negro slaves of these families.



In 1852 the new church, now called Providence Baptist Church, was built on land deeded by Mrs. Buran. In later years Mr. Jewett Shannon deeded a total of one acre of land to be used as a community cemetery. (1. [We Wanted to be Called Green Eyes](#), By: Helen Collins Selman.)

According to the administrators of the Rico Cemetery, this is a community cemetery, not specifically the Providence Baptist Church Cemetery; however, burial in the cemetery is limited to members of Providence Baptist Church and Rico United Methodist Church and their family members.

As of February 2018, there are 610 grave markers in the cemetery, including 90 unmarked stones.

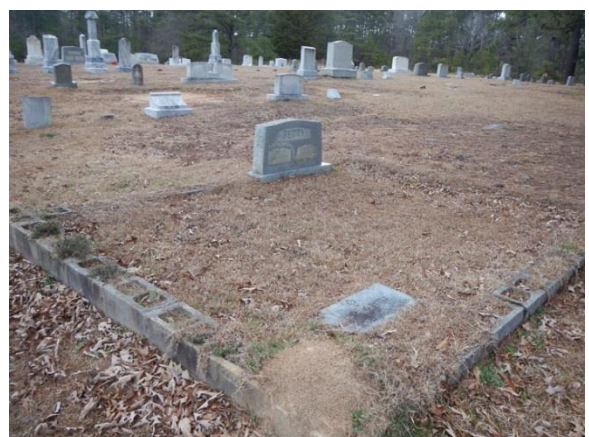
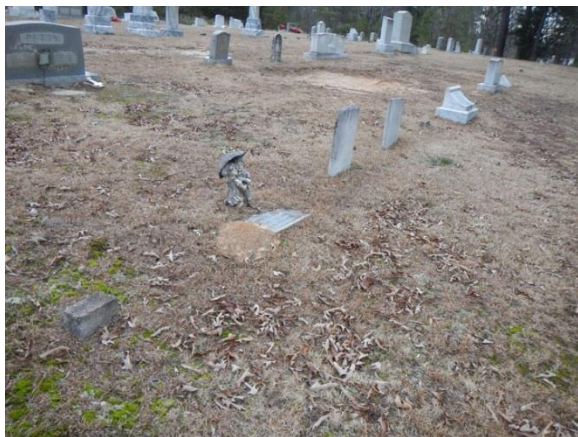

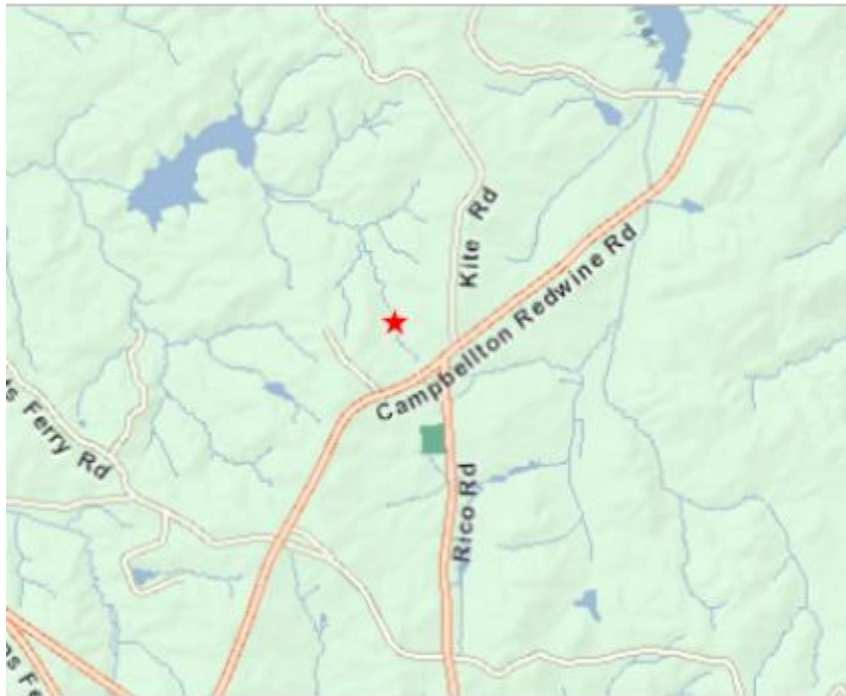

PROJECT NOTES

2/12/2018 – Laurie Searle

This project was started back in 2009, with the first five rows of tombstones surveyed. I did a new survey in February 2018 and compared my recordings to those in resident Kay Long's master survey she keeps. Where the inscriptions were different, I used the inscription on the tombstone. In some cases, Kay said there were no markers but information had been passed down from those in the community. Where I used that information I put a comment in the inscription column of the tombstone spreadsheet.

Resident Ken Langley is reviewing the tombstone spreadsheet to add antidotal information he has from his community knowledge. For example, two tombstones are inscribed with the surname spelled "Demonia." Ken said this family name was commonly spelled Demoney, as in the Burson Demoney Family Cemetery off Garretts Ferry Rd. Recording this antidotal information may be valuable for family research, so it will be included as notes in the inscription column of the spreadsheet.

Concerning the cemetery map, I am still considering the best way to record this information. I have learned that having a map can be invaluable over time, as some tombstones in other cemeteries have gone missing, been buried by fallen trees, or accidentally destroyed. However, creating a map for a cemetery as large as Rico, with more than 600 grave sites, and more to come, is challenging. For now, I've included the aerial photo of the Rico Cemetery.

To assist in locating the grave sites, I've numbered each by row and position. Row 1 is closest to Campbellton Redwine Rd. As you enter the cemetery from the parking lot, it is to the right. I counted 20 rows in all, with a single double headstone in row 20.
