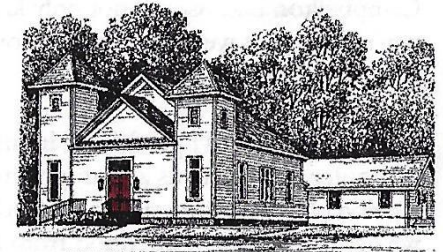

The story of Campbellton is as rich as our dark soil, which holds the earthly remains of Union and Confederate soldiers, as well as slaves and former slaves. All were either members or -- in the case of the Union soldiers -- touched in some way by the faith and caring of this enduring body of believers.
